

Save Our Shrine

- The Shrine was built in 1850.
- It has been continuously staffed by the Oblates of Mary Immaculate (OMIs).
- Annually, OMIs celebrate 1,092 Masses affording many people the opportunity to attend daily Mass before work, on their lunch hour, or after work.
- Weekly, OMIs offer 40 hours for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- Over 600 pilgrims visited the Shrine during the Jubilee Year of Hope. Many traveled long distances, including from Spain, Italy, and Uganda.
- The Shrine is open daily for people to sit quietly and pray.
